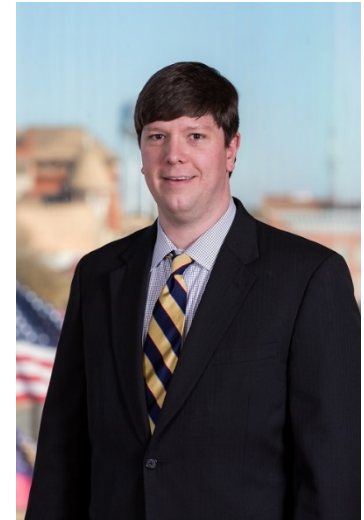

Locally, Bardin serves as a Board Member of the Americus-Sumter County Hospital Authority, as well as the Americus Housing Authority.
